



## Appendix 4: Local specific lead times

---

### Valid for location Bielefeld

Version: 01.08.2011

- Transport days are the days of the week, namely from Monday until Friday. Saturdays, Sundays and holidays extend the stated due dates by the respective number of days.
- The named lead times start with the transport notification of the shipment. The time of transportation starts with the provision of the goods.
- Loading and unloading is in general not possible on Saturdays. Some receiving plants can define Saturday as a loading and/or unloading day in the local specification temporarily or permanently.
- Time of transportation for outgoing goods (e.g. transport of empties, reshipment of material, etc.) is similar to the time of transportation of regular material shipments.
- Lead times of small shipments see appendix 2.
